What is DUI MAT?

The DUI MAT Integration and Outreach Project (DUI MAT) is one of over 26 projects in the DHCS Mat Expansion Project, State Opioid Response 2 (SOR 2) and is funded by SAMHSA and DHCS.

The project meets the goal of creating new MAT and other addiction treatment access points through integration with DUI Programs located in California’s high-risk areas. 25 DUI Programs subcontract with The California Association of DUI Treatment Programs to provide DUI MAT services in 49 locations.

DUI MAT, SOR 2 ends on September 30, 2022. The DUI MAT Project for SOR 3 is *pre-approved* by DHCS with the final approval expected in September.

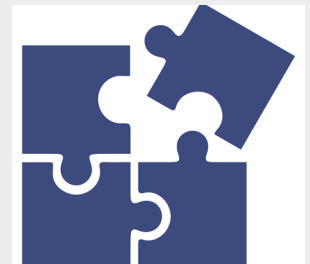
